### 1. Purpose

To recognize and reward PMI North Saskatchewan Chapter (PMI-NSC) members who support the Chapter's sponsorship outreach efforts by referring new sponsors

### 2. Eligibility

- a. Only current PMI-NSC members in good standing are eligible to participate.
- The referral must result in a successfully secured sponsor defined as a completed and confirmed sponsorship agreement with cheque received by PMI-NSC.
- c. The referral must be for a new sponsor (i.e. not an existing sponsor of the chapter).

#### 3. Incentive Structure

Members who refer sponsors that meet the pre-specified eligibility criteria will be rewarded with a combination of a Professional Development Day (PDD) discount and a gift card, as detailed below:

Sponsorship Tier	PDD Discount	Gift Card Value
Gold Sponsor	100%	\$100 CAD
Silver Sponsor	50%	\$75 CAD
Bronze Sponsor	25%	\$50 CAD
Base Sponsor	25%	\$25 CAD

### 4. Recognition

Members with the highest number of successful referrals shall be publicly recognized in the PMI-NSC newsletter following the PDD event.

The PMI-NSC Board of Directors, either acting as a body, or through powers delegated to (a) board member(s) or board committee, shall establish the criteria for determining the number of members that qualify for this recognition.



#### 5. Referral Process

Members must submit sponsor referral details to the Director of Sponsorships by email at **sponsorship@pminorthsask.com** or through any other means advised by the VP of Marketing.

### The email should include:

- a. Sponsor company name and key contact details.
- b. Sponsorship tier being pursued.
- c. Member's name and PMIID.

### 6. Additional Notes

- a. All referral activities must align with PMI-NSC's Sponsorship Policy and the chapter's other ethical standards and bylaws.
- b. PMI-NSC reserves the right to verify referrals and reject ineligible or duplicate claims.
- c. The PMI-NSC Board of Directors retains final decision authority on incentive distribution.
